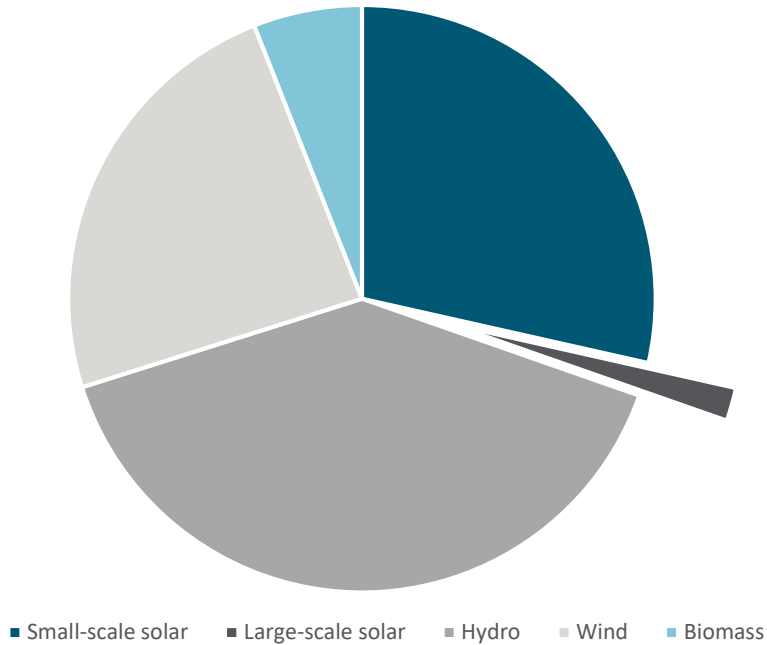

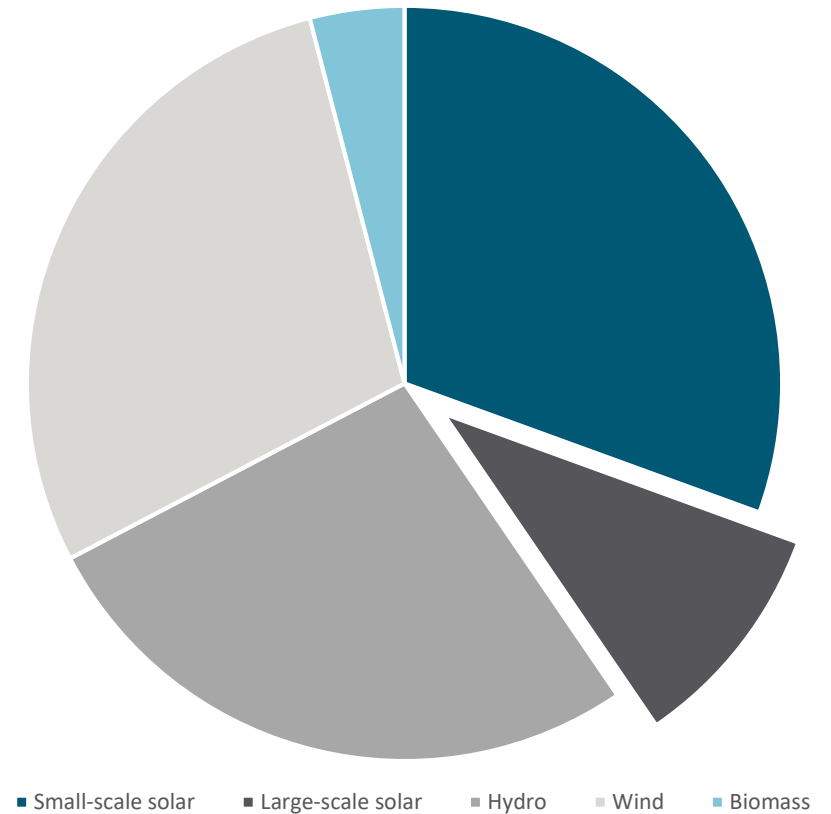

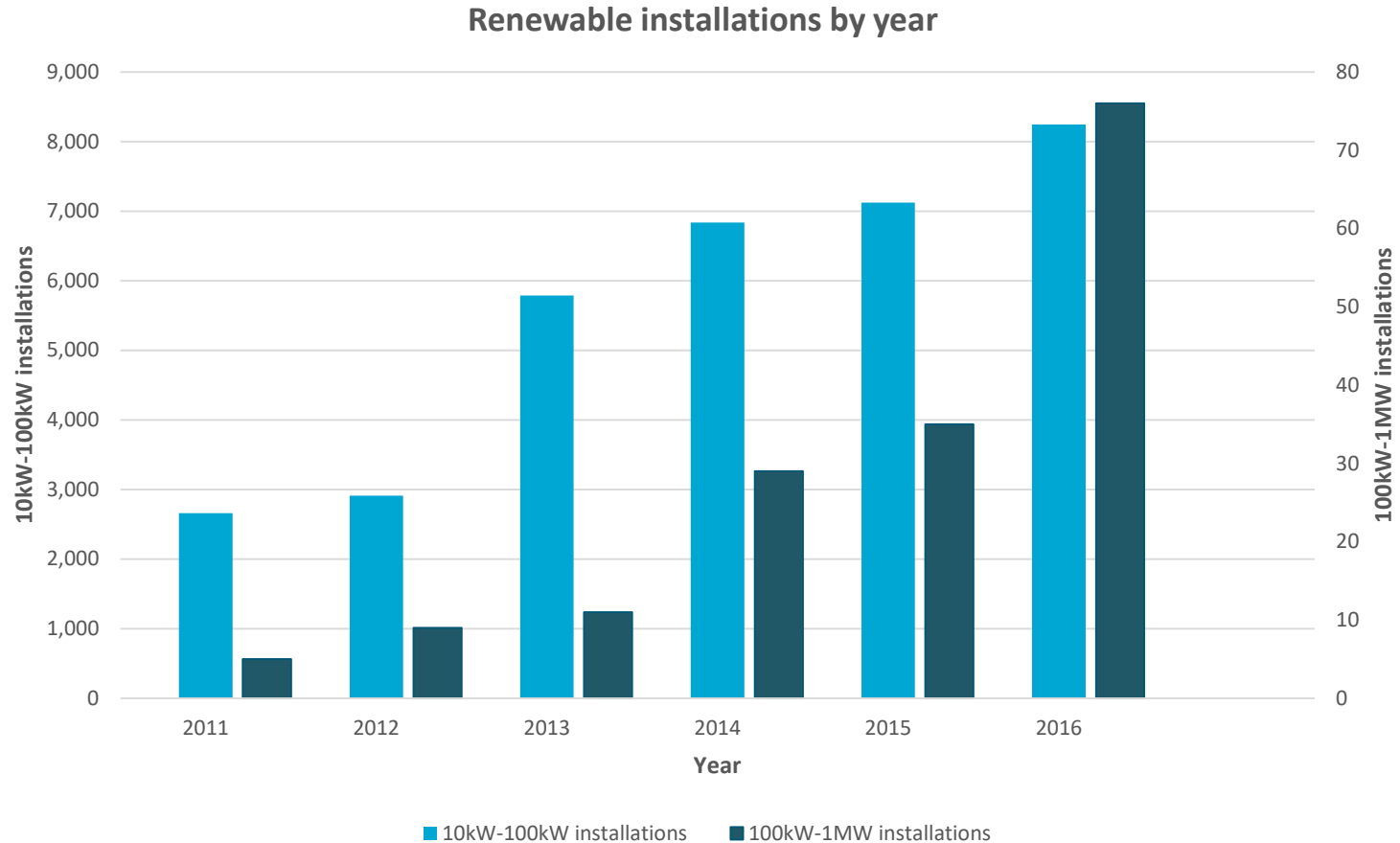

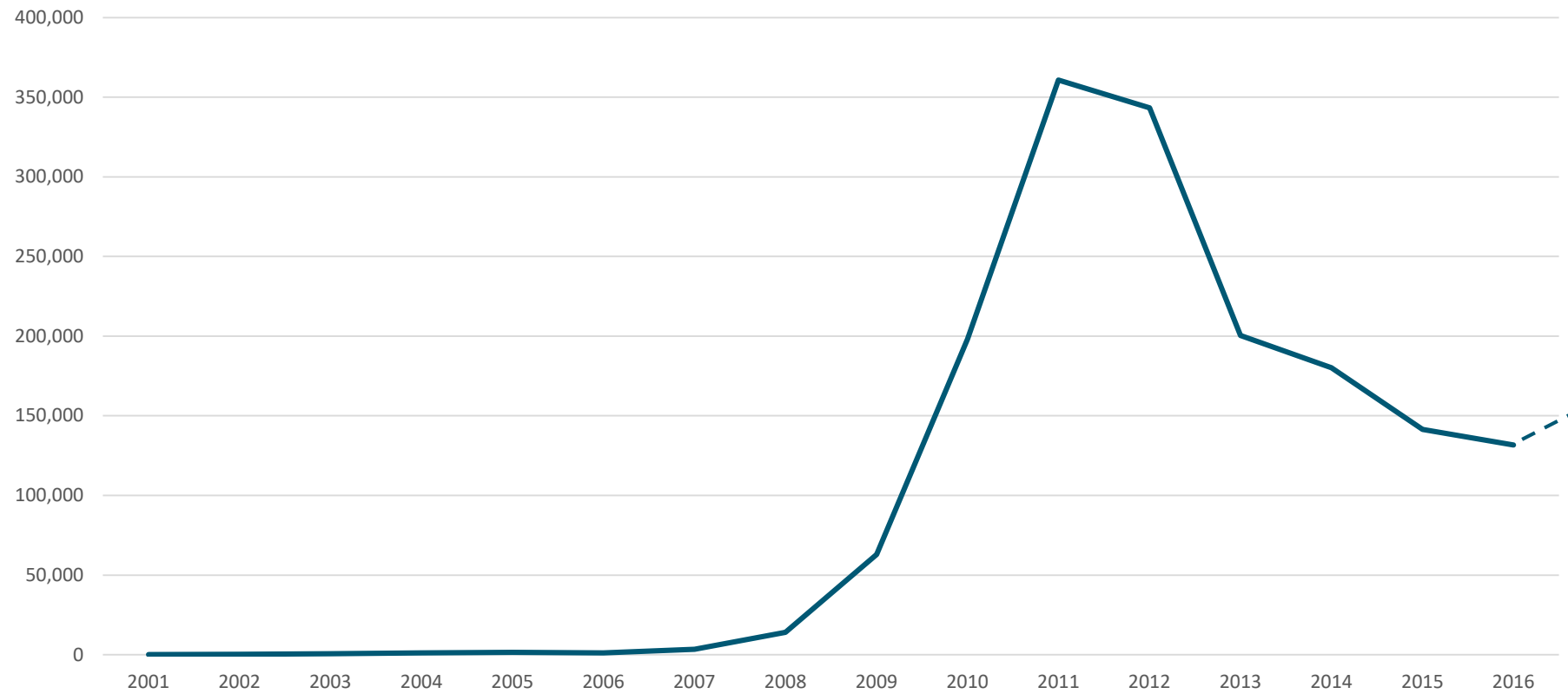


Activity in commercial and industrial solar



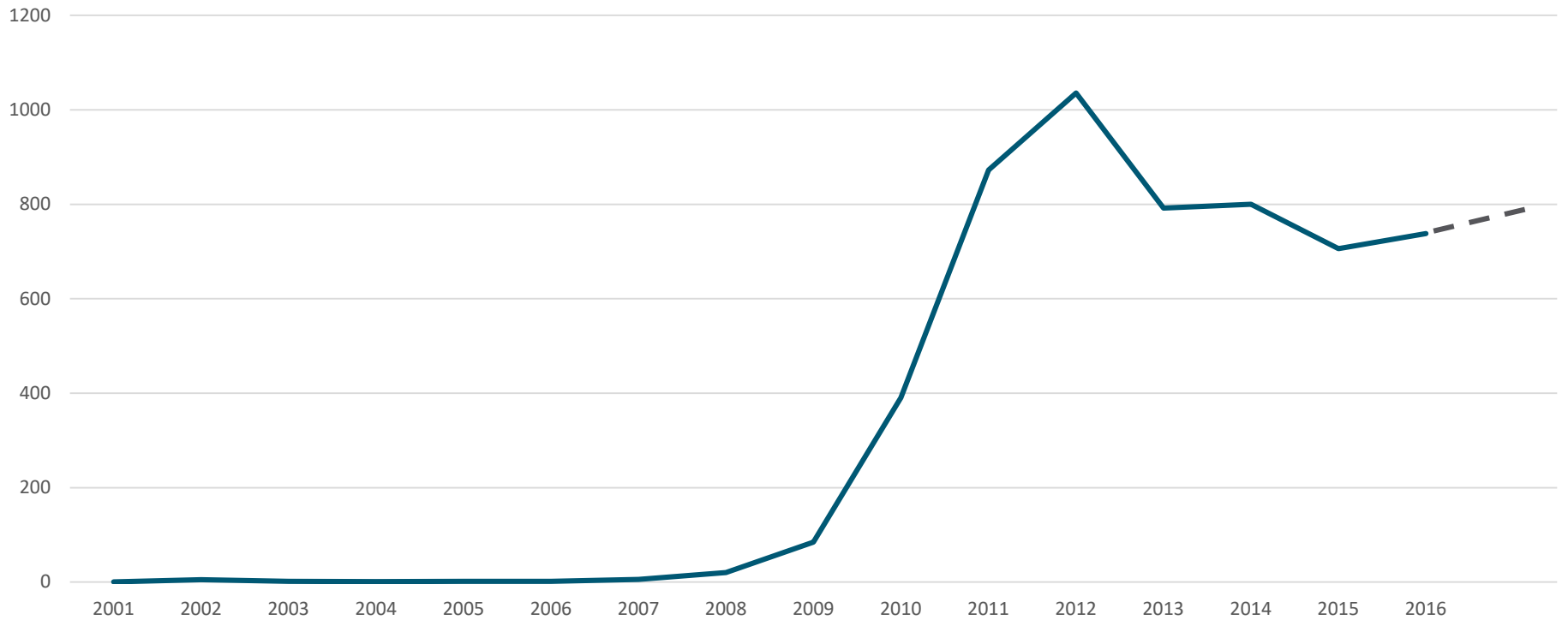
Household solar trends
