



Wood Waste Eligibility Assessment Sheet

Category 3: Waste products from the construction of buildings or furniture [Renewable Energy (Electricity) Regulation 8(1)(c)]

Records are to be retained for each delivery. Where multiple deliveries (truckloads) have been sourced from a single site (for example, delivery of 10 truckloads of relatively homogenous waste collected from a single furniture manufacturer), details of all loads from that site can be recorded on a single form. Individual records should be retained for all separate loads sourced from different sites.
